District	Legislator	Score	Notes
1	Richard Neal	1.5	Was pressured by constituents for many years, has been resistant to supporting, but activists in district also developed a combative relationship.
2	Jim McGovern	5	Very strong supporter of the bill, outspoken advocate of single-payer.
3	Niki Tsongas	2	Has faced scattered pressure to support, but not a concerted campaign from district. Has hedged public comments on the issue.
4	Joseph Kennedy	2	Relatively new rep in the state, has not responded to requests to co-sponsor, but also not faced a campaign. Not on the record in favor or opposition.
5	Katherine Clark	4	Fairly strong supporter, history in the state legislature as well. Has not taken on any leadership roles yet, but needs to be asked!
6	Seth Moulton	2	Also somewhat new, has faced very little organized pressure to support the bill so far. Not on the record for or against the concept.
7	Michael Capuano	4	Was very outspoken single-payer advocate during the ACA fight, signed on as co-sponsor only after pressure this year. Needs asks to take on leadership roles.
8	Stephen Lynch	3	Past co-sponsor of HR676 who has not been on board for a number of years now, but hasn't expressed opposition. Close to organized labor.
9	William Keating	2	Not on record for or against. Very high level of support for single-payer on the Cape, though - used to be organized wall-to-wall.
