Getting from McCarran International Airport to the Four Queens Hotel

Las Vegas provides several options for getting from the airport to your hotel: ***we recommend that you support unionized taxi and bus drivers***, and will list these options first, but will list alternative options at the end.

Bus:

Public Transit WAX- Westcliff Airport Express costs \$2 each way. You can pick it up from the airport and get dropped off at Fremont St.
