## 2018 Twin Cities Single Payer Strategy Conference

This sheet goes over the best options for getting from MSP International Airport to the Radisson Blu Downtown (35 S 7th St, Minneapolis, MN)

**By far the easiest way to get to the hotel is by Light Rail Transit (LRT).** After that, we suggest you use a unionized cab.

### Light Rail Transit (LRT)

There are light rail stations in Terminal 1 and Terminal 2 of MSP airport. Get on a **Northbound train** (towards Minneapolis-Target Field) on the **blue line**. The train will take you to downtown Minneapolis in about 25 minutes. Get off at the **Nicollet Mall station**. From there it's a 5 minute to the Radisson Blu Hotel.

Trains run every 10 minutes during peak hours and typically every 10 to 15 minutes at other times of the day. You can purchase tickets from the vending machines in front of the rail. Tickets cost \$2-\$3 each way.
